The last information update we provided is for meetings held in public buildings in the cities of Montreal, Longueuil, Boucherville and Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville all of which have been suspended until further notice due to the closure of the premises. There will certainly be other smaller cities around Montreal and in Montérégie that will adopt similar measures. Laval has not yet decided to close its public facilities, but it's probably a matter of time.
